

Dear Valued Customer,

This letter provides information on Tripp Enterprises' plans with regard to product compliance with the European Union's (EU) Directive 2011/65/EU, Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS).

The RoHS directive becomes valid on June 8, 2011 in the member states of the European Union. Its aim is to reduce a total of six substances from Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE), thereby contributing to the protection of human health and the environment. Although RoHS is a European Union Directive, manufacturers of EEE outside Europe must also abide by this legislation if the equipment they produce is ultimately imported into an EU member state.

The RoHS Directive restricts the use of certain hazardous substances commonly used in the manufacturing of electronic equipment and requires producers of electronic equipment to reduce the concentration of these hazardous materials, cited by EU Directive 2002/95/EC, by July 1, 2006, to the following

acceptable levels by weight:

Lead (Pb) < 0.1%

Mercury (Hg) < 0.1%

Cadmium (Cd) < 0.01%

Hexavalent Chromium (CrVI) < 0.1%

Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB) < 0.1%

Polybrominated Diphenyl Esters (PBDE) < 0.1%

When required, Tripp Enterprises supplies fully-documented RoHS compliant parts, assemblies and materials. Our compliance process is as follows:

- Compliant part orders are forwarded to Project Management for review. All materials and processes used to make the part are checked for compliance and for a supplier compliance letter on file. If any difficulties arise in review the customer is contacted for guidance.
- Compliant orders are entered into our system as such, and internal compliance flags alert warehouse and production personnel that the order must be compliant. The phrase 'RoHS Compliant' will also print on the packing list and the invoices.
- Compliant parts and shipping containers are labeled with a RoHS label.
- A dated letter is sent with the shipment declaring that the part is compliant. It is our policy to provide this letter the first time we ship a compliant part and for any subsequent revision changes. This will reduce the amount of documentation our customers will need to file.

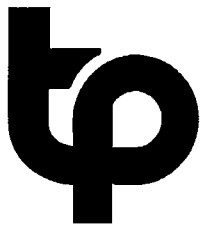
